BLAINE COUNTY ENCOURAGES HOUSEKEEPING AND CLEANING SERVICES TO RESUME

Blaine County Commissioners are acknowledging that residential housekeeping and cleaning services located and operating in Blaine County may resume operations, as long as they adhere strictly to personal health and safety procedures intended to prevent coronavirus transmission. The April 15, 2020 Idaho Department of Health and Welfare Amended Self-Isolation Order includes these services under the “Essential Businesses” category, because they contribute to maintaining the sanitation of residences.

As workers in this sector of industry return to work, they are urged to adhere to the following safety guidelines for preventing the spread of coronavirus:

- Wear a mask and clean gloves at all times while performing cleaning activities;
- Do not perform any cleaning activities while occupants are present;
- Abide by social distancing practices while performing cleaning activities;
- Ensure all cleaning rags and towels are properly washed and sanitized; and, do not reuse cleaning rags or towels between cleaning engagements.

Commissioner Jacob Greenberg said that “Having these household workers return to work helps not only with essential home sanitation, but also reducing stress for people living in unsanitary conditions.”
