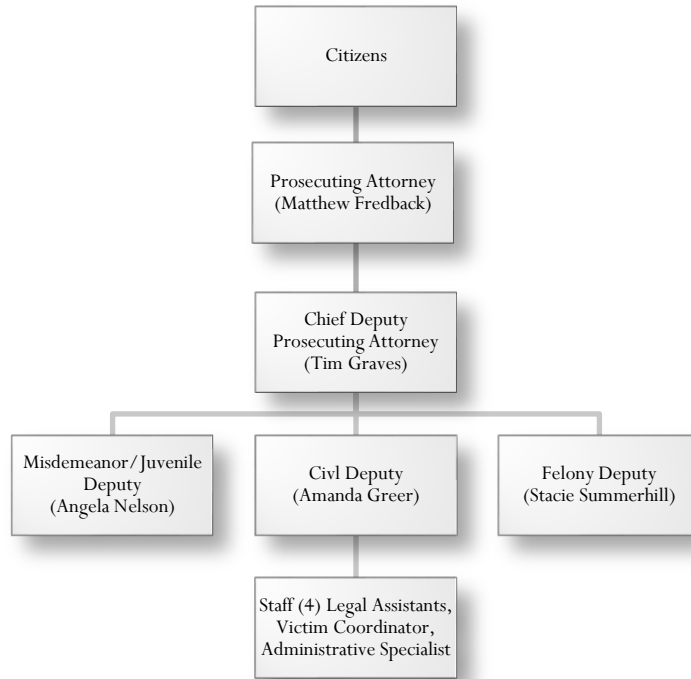
Operational Description
